A speech delivered by the leader of CBI, Hon. Madu Nwabiafra

on the occasion of the Biafra's 41st Independence Anniversary Remembrance Day

Fellow Biafrans (in Israel), shalom ùìåí!

Today, the 30th of May, 2008, we, the members of the Campaign for Biafra independence (CBI), in Israel, remember, and observe, in a special way, the 41st Anniversary of the Biafran Independence. We observe this in conjunction with all the Biafrans at home and abroad. We especially thank the Movement for the Actualization of the Sovereign State of Biafra (MASSOB), which has already started this anniversary with a one million man protest march throughout the Eastern Region. News reporters have said that five million Biafrans turned out for the programme, and marched non-violently, and unarmed, from Okigwe to Enugwu, via Owerre, where they were prevented from entering the Owerre town by the combined force of the Nigerian army and police, who blocked the road with armored cars.

Today, 41 years ago (precisely May 30, 1967), we, the people of the Eastern Region (Igbo, Efik, Ijaw, and Ogoja) seceeded from Nigeria, and declared ourselves an independent nation in the name of the Republic of Biafra. The proclamation of secession and independence, which became inevitable, and which was occasioned by the contunued programmed mass killings of the Easterners in the Norther Region, and the looting and destruction of their properties, was made by the then governor of the Eastern Region, Gen. Chukwuemeka Odumegwu Ojukwu, with parliament, in the Biafran capital city of Enugwu. The people of the Eastern Region were festive with joy and celebrations, thanking the Almighty God for their protection and freedom. But corrupt and evil Nigeria invaded Biafra on July 6, 1967, in a full scale war which eventually forced the latter to a surrender in 1970. Since the so called end of the, Nigeria had occupied and ruled Biafra till this day. But here again, since the year 2000 (30 years after the independence war, and 33 years after Nigeria invaded and occupied Biafraland). Biafrans (under the umbrella of MASSOB, and the other allied bodies throughout the world) are once more demanding their freedom and independence from Nigeria, and asking the international community to accord them recognition as an independent nation. Since 1990, some 40 new nations in Europe have made similar demands, and have gotten their independence. The latest of these nations is Kossovo, with a population of just over 2 million people. Biafra has a population of 40 million.

Our right to freedom and self-determination is indubitable, and is enshrined in the various United Nations instruments. For Example, article 1, paragraph 2 of the Charter of the united Nations points out that "respect for the principle of equal rights and self determination of peoples" is the basis for the development of friendly relations among nations. Article 1 paragraph 1 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights states that "All Peoples have the right of self-determination", and that 'By virtue of that right, they freely determine their political status, and freely pursue their economic, social, and cultural development. "And the United Nations Declaration on the Rights on Indigenous Peoples, having stated in articles 1,2,and 3 that "Indigenous peoples have the right to the full and effective enjoyment of all human rights and fundamental freedoms

recognized in the Charter of the United Nations, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and international human rights law", and that "Indigenous... peoples are free and equal to all other...peoples in dignity and rights", and that they "have the right of self determination", goes on to say that "Indigenous peoples have the right to own, use, develop, and control the lands, territories and resources that they possess by reason of traditional ownership, or other traditional occupation or use, as well as those which they have otherwise acquired." (see art. 26). And very importantly, article 43 made it clear that all these rights (all the rights in the Declaration) "constitute the minimum standards for survival, dignity and well-being of the indigenous peoples of the world".

Biafrans are autochthonous in Biafraland. They are the indigenous inhabitants of that land, and their rights which the Nigerian State is still depriving them, day in and day out, of, are internationally recognized as the minimum standards for survival, dignity, and well-being. Whereas in the demand for the right to self determination and independence, Biafra aligns with the United Nations, the deprivation of these rights by Nigeria, on the other hand, offends against the spirit of the free and democratic world, and of the united Nations. Nigeria, which is ruled by the moslem and Hausa/Fulani ethnic group, is clearly and enemy of the world, of freedom, and of democracy.

Added to the ongoing brutalities and killings being meted out to the people of Biafra in their homeland, is the fact that the 1967-1970 war between Biafra and Nigeria, has left an indelible mark in the minds of the two nations. The wickedly prosecuted war of genocide, which resulted in the death of some 3,000,000 Biafrans (especially the Igbos who form 80% of the po;pulation of Biafra), expectedly, created a near perpetual psychological enemity between the two nations of Biafra and Nigeria, an enmeity which manitests in all spheres of interaction among them. Is it therefore any surprise that Nigeria has always marginalized Biafra, and has always made policies that are directed at weakening, oppressing, and surpressing the Biafrans in every endeavour of life, including education, business ventures, as well as cultural development. Hence there is, for example, the quota system in education (occasioned by the Nigerian Government's wicked concept of "Educationally disadvantaged states", by which a qualified Biafran is deprived entry into the university, to make room for an unqualified Hausa/Fulani to get in.

Just as Satan is the enemy and the adversry, so is Nigeria the enemy and adversary of Biafra, especially of the Igbos whom Nigeria hates simply because they see them as having Jewish blood, having claimed that they are a lost tribe of Israel, as well as for being an exceptonally enterprising people. Hence the Igbos are called the "Jews of Africa", and persecuted as such. As a source rightly observed, "each time there is a mayhem (in Nigeria), the Igbos are always the prime target of massacre".

We need to remind ourselves, fellow Biafrans, that the chronicle of persecution and brutalities against the igbos and their neighbours by Nigeria goes back to even pre-independence times:

- 1. In 1945, 15 years before the Nigeria's independence, in Jos (Northern Nigeria), the Igbos were victims of massive attacks. Many of them were hunted down and killed just because they were Igbos, and enterprising.
- 2. In 1953, 7 years before Nigeria's independence, the Igbos were again victims of massive attack in Kano, (Northern Nigeria), resulting in untold deaths. One Mallam Inua Wade the secretary of Northern Nigeria Native Administration had mobilized 1000 men for what he called a "planned strike". Two days latter (on 16 May, 1953) 200 Igbos were killed. Another source said 245 Igbos were wounded while "more than 52" were killed.
- 3. In 1966 (between May and December alone), 50,000 Igbos (who were also Christians) were murdered all over Northern Nigeria by the moslem Hausa and Fulani, in three group targeted genocidal attacks which occured in May 29, July 29, and September 29 of that year (as well as the mass execution of over 300 military officers of Igbo extraction by one Ibrahim Haruna. The Reason? "Igbo resentment" (see Wikipedia). This resulted in 2,000,000 Igbos, and other south-easterners fleeing Northern nigeria, most of them maimed and traumatized.
- 4. During the 1967-1970 Nigeria- Biafra war, over 3,000,000 Igbos (Biafrans) were killed. Many of their Biafran neighbours of Effik, Ijaw, and Ogoja, suffered the same fate as well. And Nigeria refused foreign aid entering Biafra, blockading it by air, land, and sea, resulting in the starvation and eventual death of very, very many Biafrans, especially children, and pregnant women.
- 38 years since the so called end of the war in 1970, Northern Nigerian moslem ethnic group of the Hausa-Fulani has continued, the persecution and killing of the Biafrans, and especially, as usual, the Igbo.
- 1. In 1980, in Kano (Northern Nigeria), hundreds of Igbos (Igbos are Christians) were killed by the Maitasine sect of Islam.
- 2. In 1982, in Maidufuri (Northern Nigeria), hundreds of Igbos were killed.
- 3. In 1984, Jimeta, Yola (Northern Nigeria), hundreds of Igbos and other southerners were killed.
- 4. In 1985, in Gombe (Northern Nigeria), hundres of Igbos were killed.
- 5. In 1987, in Kaduna and Kafanchan (Northern Nigeria),, not only that the Igbos were killed in their hundreds, their properties were also looted.
- 6. In 1991, in Bauchi, Katsina, and Kano(Northern Nigeria), the Igbos and some other southerners were killed.
- 7. In 1992 in Zango Kataf (Northern Nigeria), many Igbos were killed.

- 8. In 1994, in Kano (Northern Nigeria), hundreds of Igbos were killed. And Mr Gideon Akaluka, and Igbo trader, was not only beheaded, but his head was also publically paraded around Kano as would a trophy. The Nigerian government looked away, and did nothing.
- 9. In the year 2000, in Kaduna (Northern Nigeria), the Sharia rioters killed 2000 Christians, most of whom were also Igbo.
- 10. Between the years 2000 and 2008, at least 2000 MASSOB members (also Igbos) have been killed by the security forces of the Hausa /Fulani moslem Nigerian Government. As at today, May 30, 2008, more than 1000 MASSOB members are being held in the various Nigerian prisons.

The killing of the Igbos by the Hausa/Fulani still continues today. Just Thursday, last week, (19 May, 2008), in Kaduna(Northern Nigeria), Mr. Kingsley Onu (an Igbo) was killed and burnt to ashes. The State Deputy Commissioner of Police, one Mr Adams Audu (himself a northerner) reporting the incident said: "...some youths numbering about 50... armed themselves with dangerous weapons and ... invaded the police station where Onu was being detained over the matter, forcefully removed him from the cell, killed him and burnt his body to ashes... and also proceeded and burnt down his shop and belongings worth about 5 million Naira" (\$42,000=).

Can anyone tell me why the Biafrans should be continually forced against their will to answer, and be part of, Nigeria in the face of these circumstances?

My fellow Biafrans, too may supreme sacrifices have been paid by our people both young and old in the course of this journey to our freedom. The blood of our heroes shall not be in vain.

The Campaign for Biafra Independence (CBI), Israel, therefore calls on Great Britain, the United States of America, and their allies, the holy State of Israel, the United Nations, and the entire International Community, to please come to our aid, and put pressure on Nigeria to stop the percecution and killing ofthe Biafran people, and to set free all the more than one thousand MASSOB members now held, and languishing, in the various Nigerian prisons; and finally, to please accord recognition to Biafra as an independent nation

Long live Biafra!

Long live the State of Israel!

Long live the International Community!

Fellow Biafrans:

We see that the Spirit of Biafra is alive and well in you, as demonstrated during Biafra's Independence Day Celebration activities last week and on May 30. We also see the other side of this coin: that you are well and alive as Biafrans, and you are strong in Biafra; you, as the People of Biafra, breathe life into Biafra—which is as it should be. What a spectacular show—what you performed and how you performed it in remembrance and celebration of Biafra; and recommittal to Biafra! What a show of strength and courage, a demonstration of bravery, and a striking statement of clarity and commitment: Biafra now, Biafra always, Biafra, a must!

We also see that the world over, Biafrans in Diaspora observed May 30 and celebrated Biafra's Independence Day with purpose and passion, with pro-Biafra / pro-MASSOB support action, showing that whether residing at home or abroad, all Biafrans are focused one goal: Biafra—Biafra, as our only country; Biafra, as our only nation; Biafra, a must.

We are grateful to you for proving that Biafra is here to stay. That's the meaning behind finding the very elderly turning up with "limp and cane" to march in the pro-Biafra May 30-related Million-Man March; that's the meaning of finding children spontaneously abandoning their wonted play and stubbornly joining the Million Man March. That's the meaning of 5 million Biafrans jamming the road all the way from Okwe to Owerri, while other eager Biafrans could not even get a literal foothold to get started. Biafra is here to stay: you have once again proved it. Biafra appreciates your confirming and affirming this Truth.

Now, no one has to tell you or remind you that we have to continue as if the March continues—continues until Biafra is politically and practically ours. Yes, the March is not over—not yet: not until we get to the Promised Land, Biafra. This means that we carry ourselves as Biafrans; conduct ourselves as Biafrans; live, love and die as Biafrans and uphold Biafra in everything that we do, in everything that we say. This means that whether Nigeria is ambushing us, killing us,

arresting us and sending us to prison for the sake of Biafra, that we remain oblivious to her cruel antics; at the same time, remain steadfast, unwaveringly committed to the one Cause, Biafra actualization and the one Nation: Biafra. We must go about our serious Biafra business knowing that Biafra is more important than Nigeria or whatever brutality and evil Nigeria is dishing out against Biafra and against Biafrans: Biafra is more important; Biafra is that important.

However, we have to remind you that Nigeria is a confused evil monster which has no idea what laws are, not to speak of good laws even; and talk less of obeying laws. Nigeria is a place where functionaries do not understand law and do not understand responsibility with regards to those laws. Nigeria is a place where Nigerian officials trip over themselves mongering to break laws; at other times, eager to show off in public their profound ignorance of laws. Unfortunately and almost invariably, these delinquencies of Nigeria end up victimizing Biafrans. So, we read (as predicted earlier) that the government of Nigeria arrested some MASSOB members in Enugu and arraigned them in court for essentially celebrating—without violence—Biafra on May 30 2008. This leads to the conclusion that in addition to the aforementioned deficits, the Nigerian government also lacks memory, and lacks legal sense, too. Remember MASSOB-53, where the Nigeria Police arrested and detained 53 MASSOB members at a soccer event in Lagos, imprisoning them for over 2 years, with the same charges as now being parroted in the Enugu case? After 2 years, didn't Nigeria drop the case, because Nigerian government lawyers would not even show up in court to prosecute their own sham-full case? In the more recent case involving Uwazurike, the leader of MASSOB, and some MASSOB officials and other-rank MASSOB members, was it not the same charges: did the government attempt to prosecute the case, other than arguing in court and insisting that MASSOBians should not get bail, and using delay-tactics to have the MASSOB members kept in jail without bail and without prosecution? So, accept our reminder and resolve that you will not allow Nigeria's senselessness and total lack of jurisprudence slow you down on our road to Biafra.

Above all, you know that you are Morally correct and Morally obligated to get out of smothering Nigeria—we didn't tell you that: your own Self and Spirit bear witness to that incessantly. You know that you have a Divine Duty to free yourself from any condition or situation that is robbing you of God's gift of Life and Freedom, like Nigeria is: we didn't have to tell you that; your *Chi* ministers to you on that score all the time. You know that every Nation of People **owns** the Right to Self Determination; the Nation and People of Biafra have the right of Self Determination leading to Biafra's Independence and Sovereignty: this, we have been telling you all along; and now the United Nations, since September 12/13 2007, has passed Resolution A/61/295 stating and recognizing the Right of Ethnic Nations to Self Determination. Act on that which you know: we do not have to tell you to.

Biafra alive! Because it is God Who makes it so.
