MISURASATA's Delegation to the Fourth General Assembly of the World Council of Indigenous Peoples has become stranded in Panama City, Panama as a result having had their funds confiscated at the Panamanian Border earlier last week. They have requested financial assistance in the amount of \$300.00 (US) so they can return to Costa Rica. I have discussed the request with CWIS Treasurer Joe Ryan and Secretary Ken Benshoof and they agree that CWIS should grant the request.

The MISURASATA Delegation includes: Marguertta Corbello, Rafael Zelaya and Samuel Mercato . I have confirmed the membership of the Delegation with A. Wiggins in Washington D.C.

Moneys in the Amount of \$300.00 (US) should be wired by-way-of Western Union through Citibank to: the National Bank of Panama (RNB BNP) in Panama City, Panama in care of Latitia Nendez at telephone number 63-51-51.

This request has been confirmed by NCAI Delegation members: Apesanahkwat and Steve Dodge. The funds should be sent today. The expenditure of \$300.00 should be listed under the Travel Account with a notation as "constituent travel: MISURASATA".
