A weekend workshop for Native RC leaders will be held on November 11th, 12th and 13th at the North Vancouver Outdoor School in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. It will meet from Friday evening through Sunday noon. It will be restricted to people who are already leaders in RC or who are eager to take a leading position. The cost of the workshop is \$100 Canadian or \$90 United States. The organizer of the workshop is Philip Lamabull at 906 1st Ave. W., apt. 10, Seattle, Washington, 98119, U.S.A. His phone number is 206-285-1249. You may register with him.

There will be Native RC leaders present from as much of the United States and Canada as we can secure. It will be a regular workshop with counseling and theory and demonstrations and group meetings, but also it will be a planning meeting for the expansion of RC participation and leadership into more and more of the areas of Native liberation. I will be leading the workshop, but Phil Lane, the International Liberation Reference Person for Natives, Philip Lamabull, the editor of Heritage magazine, and many other Native teachers and leaders of RC will be present.


There will be a limited amount of outreach funds available. They will have to be handed out sparsely in order to get the widest possible attendance, especially from people far away. So, other funds should be secured and used wherever possible, but if you will need outreach assistance in order to attend the workshop, please write to me or phone me at 206-284-0311, specifying the exact minimum that you can get by with and attend the workshop.

Plans are being made for childcare, with the white community in Vancouver arranging for volunteers. Let us know in advance if you need childcare and how many children.

Please let Philip Lamabull know as early as possible that you plan to attend and please call me about financial requirements as early as you can. I will be away from Seattle from now until October 17th, but I will be in and out after that period.

I hope you are utilizing the marvelous new Heritage magazine to the full, selling copies to your friends whenever possible. It is one of the best things that has been done in Native RC and we need to make full use of it.
