

INTERNSHIPS

A limited number of Internships are available on-site in Mexico. A competitive application must be completed. Interns are accepted to study and serve in areas such as traditional medicine, ethnobotany, traumatic stress studies, health education, tropical public health, anthropology, somatics, health psychology, fourth world studies, politics, diplomacy, economics, environmental studies, tourism and development.

Internships are for undergraduates and graduate students or nonacademic affiliated individuals who wish to enhance their skills and participate in CWIS activities. Internships provide 20 to 25 hours a week in research and clinical/educational fields for a minimum of four weeks. Successful applicants are eligible to 2 seminars during their tenure and receive individual/group supervision from a primary faculty person. CWIS will provide documentation for credit required by the intern's institution.

SERVICE PROJECT

A 15-20 hour per week service project that supports the activities of the Center for World Indigenous Studies under either the Center for Traditional Medicine or the Fourth World Institute in Mexico is required. If mitigating circumstances preclude participation in the service project, fee arrangements will be made.

APPLICATION REQUIRMENTS

A successful applicant is resourceful, works hard, has skills to offer, is a relaxed participant in village life and is a serious learner who wishes to expand her/his potential. A successful intern can expect to engage fully in village life, experiential and theoretical learning and gain experience living in a traditional culture undergoing change. S/he may also expect to benefit from participating in a community of international scholars, clinicians and activists and gain experience that will promote the health and well-being of people as s/he expands her/his skills for a productive career.

Only complete applications will be considered. A complete

application includes the following:

- Completed and signed Application form (electronic or hard copy)
- 2. Two letters of reference
- 3. Curriculum Vitae/ Resume
- 4. Application Fee (non-refundable)
- 5. Cover letter specifying additional information to be considered

(Begin dates MUST coincide with a seminar begin date)

Internship Fees and Expenses

Interns are required to pay for 1 seminar in full, plus a one-time administrative fee and pay toward the costs of food and housing. CWIS covers the tuition costs for subsequent seminars, supervision of projects and service work.
