Since 1975, the TANTANAKUY has been taking place in Humahuaca Ravine. TANTANAKUY is a quechua origin woed meaning "meeting". It's a meeting of some with our country's Northern cultures

The TANTANAKUY is a Civil Association, without profit purposes, which objective is to enhance the cultural identity of the region.

The idea was conceived by the master musician Jaime Torres and the great poet Jaime Dávalos.

A great and diverse number of pedagogic and cultural activities take place at this Centre.

Since 1984, the CHILDREN'S TANTANAKUY has been taking place an authentic popular meeting performed by school children living in Humahuaca Ravine, which objective is to preserve their cultural heritage since childhood. This meeting takes place once ayear.

In October, 1988, a dream became truth: The TANTANAKUY'S HOUSE'S first building stage was finished; which has got an important amphitheatre and a large room in permanent activity.

FILMS FOR HUMAHUACA

PROJET: FILMS FOR HUMAHUACA

The Tantanakuy's Pedagogic Centre, placed in Humahuaca, Humahuaca Department, Jujuy, Argentina, has an important architectonic structure in regional style. Large and rustic rooms, they are luminous and with a panoramic, privileged view, The amphitheatre, stage of different open-air meetings, is a largesized place, as well as the Work Room where the majority of the workshops take place. There are also an administrative area, a second work-room (according with the requirements of a permanent cinema hall), two classromms, two rooms for the people in charge of the workshops and conditioned public bathrooms. During the 2000, the Tantanakuy's Video library is created, the first and unique in de region, with 500 titles of its property coming from different donations for a wide range of audiences. Its objective is to make its material known in the entire Humahuaca Department, in Humahuaca town and in ryral area's schools. The project CINE NOMADE is planned and, in this way, the films and Expression Workshop for Children starts, which consists in creating a place for screening movies and to promote creative expressions. At the worksop, children have access to different genres: silent movies, documentary films, educative films, cartoons, etc. Then they analize briefly what they have already seen and interpret their exprenencies through, drawings, modeling in clay, cartoons, video recording, script writing etc. This workshop provides them with the necessary material for these activities.

This worksop, which started with seven children, gathered hundreds of children in a short period of time, but the worksop couldn't keep more than fourty. It was not for lack of room or interest; it was because of the impossibility of a large film screening. At present, the workshop only has a 20 inchs T.V, which remarkably limits the audience and th subsequent children's creative development.

Jujuy Province is in need of cenema halls. If there were a projector and a large screen, a lot of children, eager to see flims, would be favoured. The whole people of Humahuaca would have a Cinema Hall to enjoy within their families and become culturally wealthier than they are at present, this would improve their life conditions and would add a healthy alternative. Children in rural schools would enjoy a cenema screen fil sporadicly, in their own schools as well as in Tantanakuy's Cinema Hall. Adults in rural villages would be also part of the audience, thus promoting communication among children, parents and teachers.

Benefits of the Project:

- Creation of the first cinema hall in Humahuaca, showing films for adults, children and a wide range of audience, contributing to the community's cultural and informative enhancement.
- Access to new and healthy options in a gratuitous way.
- > To increase the number of participants in audiovisual media workshops.
- ➤ To take the "big screen" films to schools and rural villages in the region which have no access to shows like these, as well as having people from these villages visiting the Cinema Hall.
- > To complement other subjects workshops with audiovisual media
- > To reinforce the Video library activity, promoting the use of its material as an information level
- > To improve the quality of the cultural activities having the Cinema Hall available for these.
- > To open new worlds...
