An Account Of Genocide And Atrocities Committed  
By Bangladesh Forces And Illegal Bengalee Muslim  
Infiltrators In Chittagong Hill Tracts Since  
November, 1986-January, 1987,

INTRODUCTION

Bangladesh government policy of extermination of the Jumma Nation of CHT has reached its highest peak. In order to uproot the original inhabitants, the Jumma people from their ancestral home steads and ultimately from their homeland the Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) through the most illegal and crimefull methods such as military, economic and political vengeance. On the other hand, its forceful illegal occupation of Jumma lands through its illegal Bengalee Muslim infiltrators with the direct help and support from its armed forces has gone on fullswing with maximum intensification.

Since the illegal inclusion of the non-muslim majority populated ( 98.5% ) Chittagong Hill Tracts into Pakistan the policy of changing the demographic character of CHT has been carried out by all successive governments without a break with the emergence of Bangladesh, particularly from 1971 the ignoble plan of Bangladesh government to settle thousand of illegal Bengalee muslim infiltrators with financial assistance in the CHT has led to the forcible occupation of Jumma lands by these infiltrators with the direct help from the Bangladesh armed forces. By 1985, the present government of Lt. H. M. Ershad has illegally settled about 400000 illegal Bengalee Muslim infiltrators in the CHT constituting 40%-46% of the total population. By the beginning of 1986, mass uprootment of the Jumma people and distribution of cultivable lands belonging to Jummas through forcible and illegal means have been intensified greatly by Bangladesh government. By October 1986 almost 80,000 ( eighty thousand ) innocent Jumma people have been forcibly uprooted from their ancestral homeland by Bangladesh forces and their co-partners-illegal Bengalee

Muslim infiltrators. Of these uprooted people, about 30,000 (thirty thousand) people had been forced to take refuge in the Tripura State, India for their lives. In spite of this tragedy, the innocent Jumma people are trying their utmost to live in their ancestral homelands. On the other hand, the Shanti Bahini (PEACE FORCE) the armed wing of the Jana Samhati Samiti committed to its responsibility and duty to resist the barbarous, inhuman atrocities of the Bangladesh forces and the infiltrator realising the right to self-determination of the Jumma people. Since November 1986 Bangladesh government has intensified its activities on following with barbaric ferocity in its undeclared war against the whole Jumma people. Bangladesh government has taken up various repressive measures in order to uproot the Jumma people from their ancestral homelands that is from their homeland :-

1. On the pretext of military operation against the Shanti Bahini :
  2. Setting up Joutha Khamar (collective farm), Jukta gram (collective village) and Adarsha gram (Ideal village). Bangladesh government has infact made these villages with a view to concentrating the Jummas in these strategic villages like concentration camps having military, paramilitary or police camps along with. More over, these strategic villages are situated far away from their cultivable lands. The Jummas are ordered to deposit their Tragul (iron made sharp instrument) axe, etc. to the camps authorities before 5 P. M. everyday and no one is allowed to come out their houses. As the Jumma people are reluctant to join these camps, Bangladesh government has resorted to severe persecution of the Jummas by burning down their dwellings, looting properties including cattles, atrocities etc, in order to force them to join in these concentration camps.
  3. Economic blockade and forcible confiscation of Jumma properties :- Bangladesh government forces have imposed

total restriction on sale of Jumma food grains which is the only means of production as well as this lively hood. On the other hand, Jumma food stocks, live stocks are being confiscated and looted by the Bangladesh forces and uslm infiltrators for the maintenance of the newly settled infiltrators. Sometimes the Jumma properties are thrown away here and there if these are not possible to be carried away after confiscation.

4. Pressure on elected, non-elected Jumma public office holders :- Bangladesh government is carrying out a policy of pressuring the local Jumma elected members, chairman of Union parishad (council), Upazilla (sub-district) Chairman, Karbari (village head) and Headman (in charge of an area called Mouza) etc. in co-operating with the government as stooges for the oppression of the Jumma people. They are being pressurised for political gains, if they refuse to co-operate they also face the same fate of the suffering Jumma people.
5. Pressure on the parents and relations, supporters of the JSS workers :- Pressuring the relations of the JSS workers and its supporters with inhuman tortures and dire consequences by Bangladesh forces and illegal Muslim infiltrators continues unabatedly.
6. Harrassment and beating Jumma who are Bangladesh government service holders by Bangladesh armed forces in order to implement the above mentioned repressive measures taken by the Bangladesh government atrocities and oppressions of various kinds of inhuman nature committed by Bangladesh forces and their co-partners illegal Bengali Muslim infiltrators are mentioned below :-
  1. Surprise round up of Jumma villagers,
  2. Genocide and gruesome massacre of the Jummas : For instance —
    - a) Bangladesh forces shoot dead the Jummas ; and son times chop off the Jumma men, women and children

- with Tagal which they now carry with them ;
- b) Bangladesh forces encircle the Jummas and the illegal Muslim infiltrators are given a free to carry out the genocide and massacres ;
3. Mass atrocities and tortures :-
- Water mixed with chillies/hot water being poured into mouth and nose till the Jumma victim becomes senseless ;
  - Sticking needles into fingers ;
  - Incising with knife on the body and then pasting salt and chillies on the cuts, ultimately the victim dies of gangrene ; this torture is committed in the army camps ;
  - Twisting and spraining of finger joints and the wrists so that the victim remains crippled for ever. This torture applied on the young and able bodied persons ;
  - Putting off cigarette buds on the body ;
  - Hanging upside down and beating the victim till fainting ;
  - Beating the victim indiscriminately with wooden blocks, sticks, bamboos, canes, ropes, iron rods whatever available in front of them ;
  - Undressing men and women enmasse and carrying away the Jumma women into the army camps in nude where they are raped for days and nights ;
  - Arresting men and women enmasse and kept in detention ;
  - Mass and gang raping of Jumma women by Bangladeshi forces and muslim infiltrators ;
  - Arbitrary arrests and kept in detention ; tortured with electric shock on the genitals ; kept in pits without food and water ; squeezing of testicles, hanging by one hand, kicking like football, putting inside gunny bags and dipping in water, made to look at powerful lights for hours etc.
- All these repressive measures with tortures and atrocities are going on in the CITT, such reports which have occurred

from the month of November, 1986 till today are given here with :-

- \* On 1st November, 1986 Soldiers of Captain Md Manzoor helal of 32 East Bengal Regiment ( EBR ) Bangladesh Army ( BA ), army camp at Mahal Chari, P. S. Mahal Chari, arrested the following persons and subjected them with severe beating and tortures in the camp. They are :-
- Mr. Larai Chandra Chakma, 32 years, son of Man Chandra Chakma, of Mono Ranjan Mahajan Para, P. S. Naniachar.

- \* 2ND NOV. 1986—Soldiers of captain Md. Manzoor A Helal of 32 EBR, B. A. army camp at Mahal Chari, during their operations, against innocent Jumma village of Madhya Adam, P. S. Mahal Chari, took away two bullocks by forces for slaughter from these two persons without payment.
- Mr. Suranath Chakma, 50 years, of Dewanchara, P. S. Mahal chari.
  - Mr. Lakshmi Kumar Chakma, 50 years address—do.
- \* 2ND NOV. 1986—Soldiers of 20 EBR, B. A. Dighinala Ganit. arrested an innocent Jumma who was the Head Master of Ananda Moy Primary School. He was brutally murdered by the soldiers in DEC. 1986. He is-
- Mr. Sadhan Chandra Chakma, 33 years, son of late Prema Lal Chakma, of Kamaku Chara P. S, Dighinala.
- 2ND NOV. 1986—Soldiers of 40 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Ghagra, led by a Lt. desecrated the Buddhist temple at Manik Chari. All the properties of the temple were destroyed. The temple is—
- Sap Chari Buddha viharu, Estd. 1972, Manik Chari Madhya para, No, 109 Sap Chari Mauza, PS-- Kotwali.
- \* 2 NOV. 1986—Lt. Col Matru Rehman, Commanding officer of 41 EBR from the army camp at Marishya, physically tortured a young girl of Gorasthan, Baghai Chari, The victim is :-

6. Miss Renuka of Georasthan, P. S. Baghai Chhari. She was tortured in her Khamar ghur ( farm house ). The Khamar ghar was set on fire.

\* 2 NOV, 1986—Capt. Md. MA. Helal of 92 EBR, BA from the army camp at Mahal Chhari, looted bullock for slaughter during operations against the Jumma inhabitants of Madhya Adam and Dewano chara, Names of the persons from whom bullocks were looted away by the above captain are—

7. Mr. Suranath Chakma, 50 years, of Dewano Chara, P. S. Mahal Chhari. A bullock was looted away without payment by the captain.

8. Mr. Lakshmi Kumar Chakma, 50 years, of Madhya Adam, P. S. Mahal Chhari. A bullock was looted away without payment by the captain.

\* 3RD NOV, 1986—Soldiers of 30/40 EBR, BA from Dighinala cantonment ( Cantt. ) in an army operation against the Jumma village—Akshay Anoni Karbari Para, shot dead two innocent Jumma in a Mon Char ( temporary bamboo house built by slash and burn cultivators ). After shooting the victim were taken to Dighinala hospital. On 10 Nov, 1986 the dead body were handed over to their relations. The victims are—

\* 3RD NOV, 1986—Soldiers of 32 EBR, and 40 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Rangamati and Ghagra jointly carried out army operations against the Jumma villages—Suker Chhari Khamar Para under the command of Atiquir Rehaman,

During the operations innocent Jummas were severely beaten and tortured enmasse and their dwellings were destroyed. The victims are—

12. Mr. Sarat Kumar Chakma, 32 years, son of Mr. Trooky Karbari, PS- Kotwali, was severely beaten and taken to Ghagra camp, and kept under detention.

13. Mr. Bilodhar Chakma, 28 years, son of Tulo R Chakma, address—do—, was beaten and being detained at Ghagra camp.

14. Mr. Badonya Chakma, 30 years, son of Mr. Junikk Chakma, address—do—, was beaten and being detained at Ghagra camp.

15. Mr. Chagasira Chakma, 26 years, son of Mr. Lakshmi Muni Chakma, address—do—, was beaten and kept above.

16. Mr. Chalya Chakma, 24 years, son of Mr. Dev. Sur Chakma, address—do—, was beaten and as above.

17. Mr. Purna Kanta Chakma, 38 years, son of Mr. Jalant Muni Karbari, address—do—, his house was destroyed and house hold properties were taken away.

18. Mr. Fulo Raj Chakma, 65 years, son of late Sankh Sur Chakma, address—do— and as above.

19. Mr. Puleh Chakma, 38 years, son of Jayanda Muni Chakma, address—do— and as above.

20. Mr. Sukra Kumar Chakma, 68 years, son of late Sundd Muni Chakma, address—do— and as above.

24. Amrita Monti Chakma of Indra Monti Para, Banchara, P. S. Dighinala. His house and three betel leaf gardens were burnt into ashes.

\* 4TH NOV 1986—Soldiers of 20 EBR, BA from Dighinala cantt. raided the house of an innocent Jumma at Mura Para of Pabla Khali, P. S. Dighinala, resorting to robbery. The victim is—

25. Mr. Sramanya Chakma of Mura Para Pabla Khali, P. S. Dighinala. The soldiers robbed TK. 5000 (five thousand takay) from him when they raided his house. Bangladesh army personnel now indulge in robbery.

\* 4TH NOV. 1986—Lt. Iqbal and Lt. Enamul Haq and six other soldiers 32 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Guimara, arrested three innocent persons who were beaten severely and taken to the army camp where they are being kept under detention. The victims are—

26. Mr. Sheha Kumer Chakma 45 years, son of Mr. Chain Prue Chakma, of Kumajja Karbari Para, Mouza-Brey Motom, P. S. Ramgarh.

\* 5 NOV. 1986—Under the command of the Lieutenant, soldiers of 40 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Chagra, desecrated the Buddhist temples at Sukar Chari Bor Para and Khamar Para. All the properties of these two temples have been totally destroyed. The images of Lord Buddha were also broken into pieces by these soldier. The affected temples are—

b) Sukar Chari Para Buddha Vihara, Esid, 1987, No. 110 Sukar Chari Mouza, PS- Kotwali.

\* 5 NOV. 1986—Captain Md. Monzeor A. Helal of 32 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Mahal Chari, carried out operations against the Jyotha Khamar of Chowngria Chari, PS- Mahal Chari. During the operations many innocent persons were arrested and taken to the army camp at Mahal Chari where they were subjected to physical tortures and are being detained. An innocent person was also killed by the above captain.

31. Mr. Ujjal Monti Chakma, 27 years, son of Mr. Pyari Mohan Chakma, of Chowngria Chari Jyotha Khamar, PS- Mahal Chari. The victim was arrested in his own house and taken to the army camp at Mahal Chari where he was subjected to inhuman physical torture due to which he died on 11 NOV. 1986 in the army custody. The soldiers looted a radio, destroyed his house and even cleared their bowels in his house.

36. Master Konjyo Khree Marma, 14 years, son of -do-, address -do-. He was arrested, beaten and taken to the army camp where he was further beaten. He was given release on 7 NOV. 1986.
37. Mr. Maung Thyo Marma, 18 years, son of -do-, address -do-. He was arrested beaten and taken to the army camp where he was further beaten. He was given release on 10 NOV. 1986.
38. Mr. Aung Sah Marma, 25 years, son of Mr. Suzi Marma, address -do- as above.
9. Mr. Thoi Boi Marma, 55 years, address -do-, he was beaten severely. The soldiers looted away a pair of silver bangles from his daughter
40. Mr. Mudyo Marma, 25 years, son of Mr. Prue Seh Marma, address -do-. He was severely beaten in his house.
41. Mr. Sazai Marma, 30 years, son of Mr. Sah Thazai Marma, address -do-. He is ex-Shanti Bahini member, belonging to the dissident group who surrendered to Bangladesh Government. He was also beaten up by the army personnel
42. Mr. Kyo Ching Marma, 25 years, son of Mr. Mounng Prue Marma, of Chowngra Chari Chowdury para, P, S, Mahal Chari. He was also beaten by the soldiers.

\* 10 NOV. 986—Soldiers of 40 EBR, BA, from the army camp at Ghagra, commanded by Atiqul Rehman, carried out operations against the villages Lower Kuduk Chari and Upper Kudduk Chari, beating the inhabitants, resorted to looting and molested women. The victims are.....

59. Mrs. Poly Chakma, 36 years, wife of Mr. Mono Ranjib Chakma address-do—. The soldiers tried to rape her but when they failed they beat her severely.

60. Mrs. Soradevi Chakma, 37 years, wife of Mr. Brisha Kumar Chakma, address-do—. She was inhumanly beaten.

61. M.s. Reou Chakma, 45 years, wife of Mr. Poraiya Chakma address-do—. As above.

62. Mrs. Laxmi Devi Chakma, 26 years, wife of Mr. Morottit Chakma, address-do—. The soldiers attempted to rape her but when failed they beat her severely.

63. Mr. Pureiya Chakma, 55 years, son of Mr. Chandra, Muro Chakma, address-do—. The victim was severely beaten

64. Mr. Kadam Mui Chakma, 68 years, son of late Harb Chakma, address-do—. He was severely beaten.

65. Mrs. Raj Laxmi Chakma. 25 years, wife of Mr. Sun Kumar Chakma, address-do—. The soldiers attempted to rape her but when they failed, the victim was severely beaten.



66. Mrs. Mangal Rashi Chakma, 28 years wife of Mr. Muni Chakma, address—do—. The soldiers attempted to rape her but when they failed they subjected her to severe beating.
67. Miss. Chikko Rai Chakma, 19 years, daughter of Mr. Mereiya Chakma, address—do—. As above.
68. Mrs. Devon Dhuri Chakma, 24 years, wife of Mr. Bhangya Chakma, address—do—. As above.
69. Mrs. Kripa Bala Chakma, 26 years, wife of Mr. Subha Raiya Chakma, address—do—. As above.
70. Mr. Banshi Mohan Chakma, 38 years son of Mr. Don Khyia Chakma, of upper Kuduk Chara, No—11, Kuduk Chara Mouza, P.S. Kotwali. The victim was arrested and subjected to severe beating and taken to the camp. He is still being detained. The soldiers looted away all the valuable properties including a radio, Tk. 6,000 (Six thousand), I quintal of rice and set fire on his house.
71. Mr. Lakshmi Moni Chakma, 28 years, son of Mr. Surya Kumar Chakma, address—do—. The victim was arrested, beaten severely and taken to the army camp at Chagra where he is still being detained. The soldiers looted away, 1 quintal of rice, one bullock, valuable clothes, one torch light and set fire on his house burning down two quintal of paddy along with.
72. Mr. Ukurikya Chakma, 35 years address—do—. The victim was arrested, beaten, taken to the army camp at Chagra where he is being detained. The soldiers looted away all valuable properties from his house which includes Tk. 700 (Seven hundred), gold and silver ornaments, one radio and ten kilo of kapok.
73. Mr. Nilo Bahshi Chakma, 22 years, address—do—. The victim was arrested, beaten severely and taken to the army camp at Chagra where he is still being detained. His house was set on fire and his papaya and banana gardens were destroyed by the soldiers. The soldiers also looted 117 grams of silver and one torch light from him.

74. Mr. Krishna Rajan Chakma, 19 years, address—do—. The victim was arrested, beaten and detained like his brother as above.
75. Mr. Surya Kumar Chakma, 55 years, address—do—. The soldiers arrested the victim and after severe beating took him to the army camp at Chagra where he is still being detained. They set fire on his house and destroyed the surrounding eight quintals of paddy, two blankets and valuable clothes.

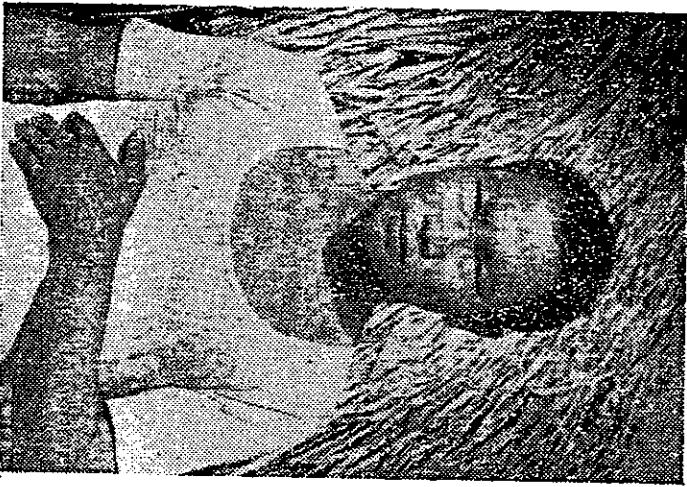

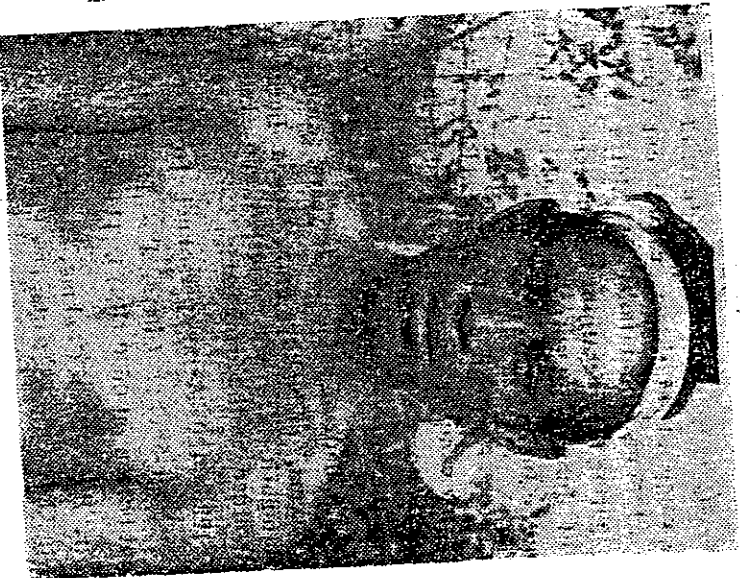

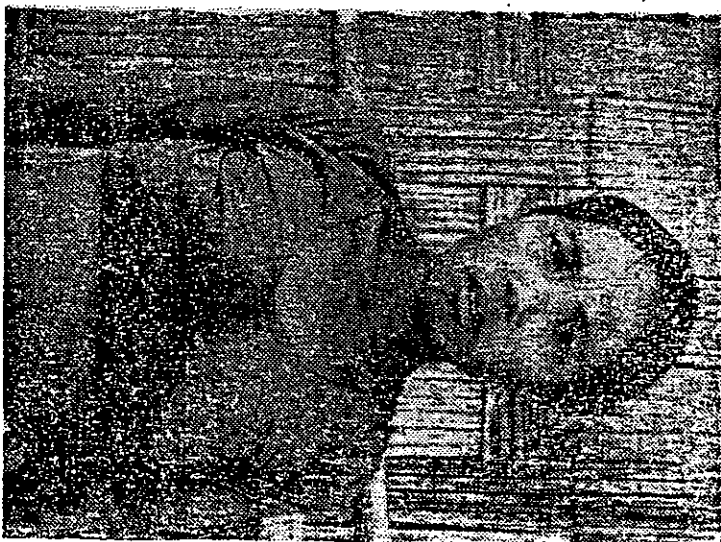
