In order to educate and involve public concern and discussion of the recent events of September 11th, the Center for World Indigenous Studies will host a 1 hour panel discussion offered in the Olympia Center in Olympia, Washington.

**One of the issues of concern in this forum is the implications of the New War for
Fourth World peoples.**

The United States Department of State has listed twenty-six organizations as Foreign Terrorist Organizations. Of the twenty-six organizations designated by the US Department of State as Foreign Terrorist Organizations (FTO), five are internal resistance organizations representing Fourth World nations. If one counts Palestine as a Fourth World nation then eight of the twenty-six are designated as FTOs. Jane's Information Group lists 146 groups in seventy-two states designated either as "insurgency" or "terrorist" organizations. Of these groups, 73 organizations represent Fourth World nation resistance movements.
