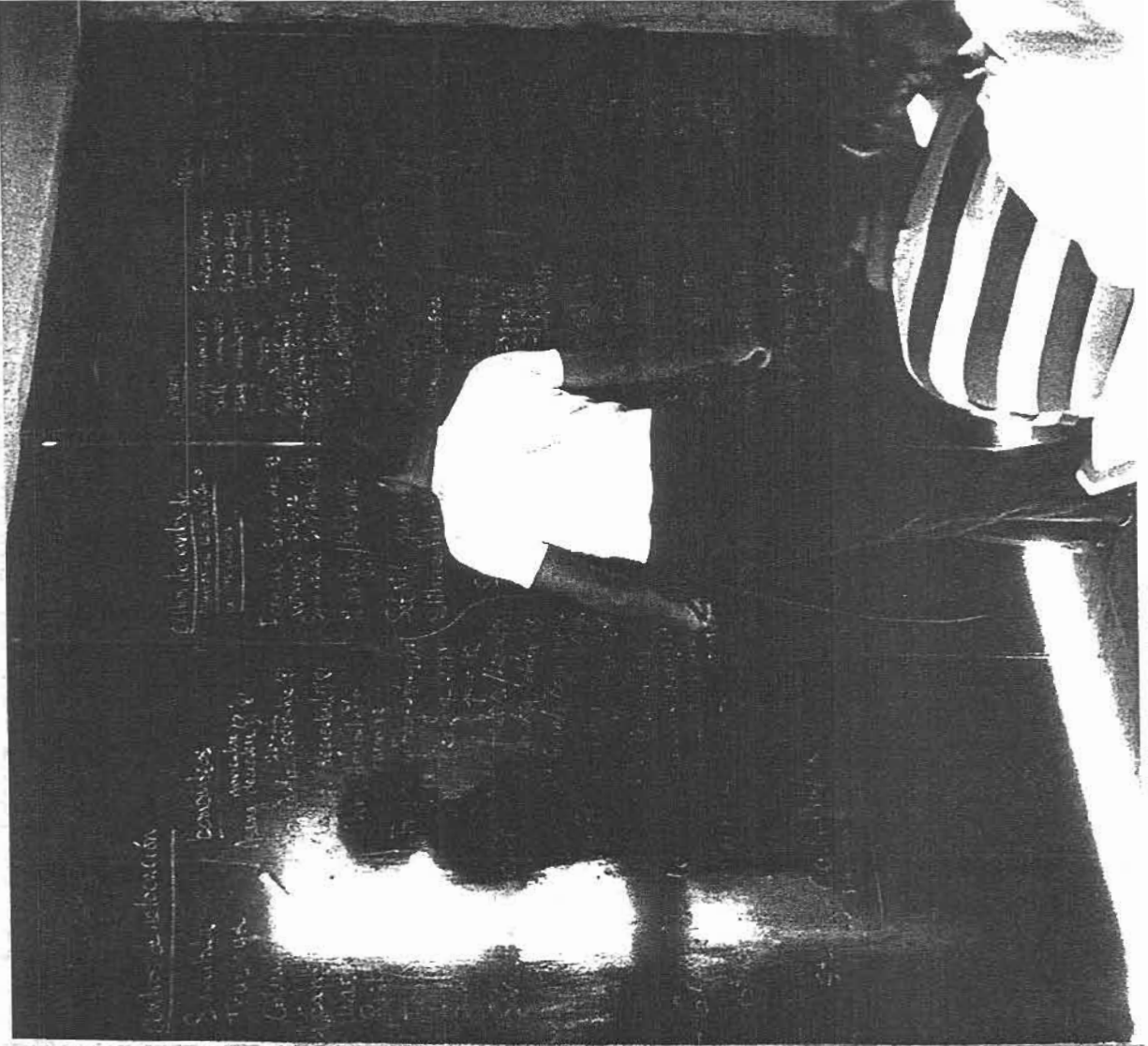
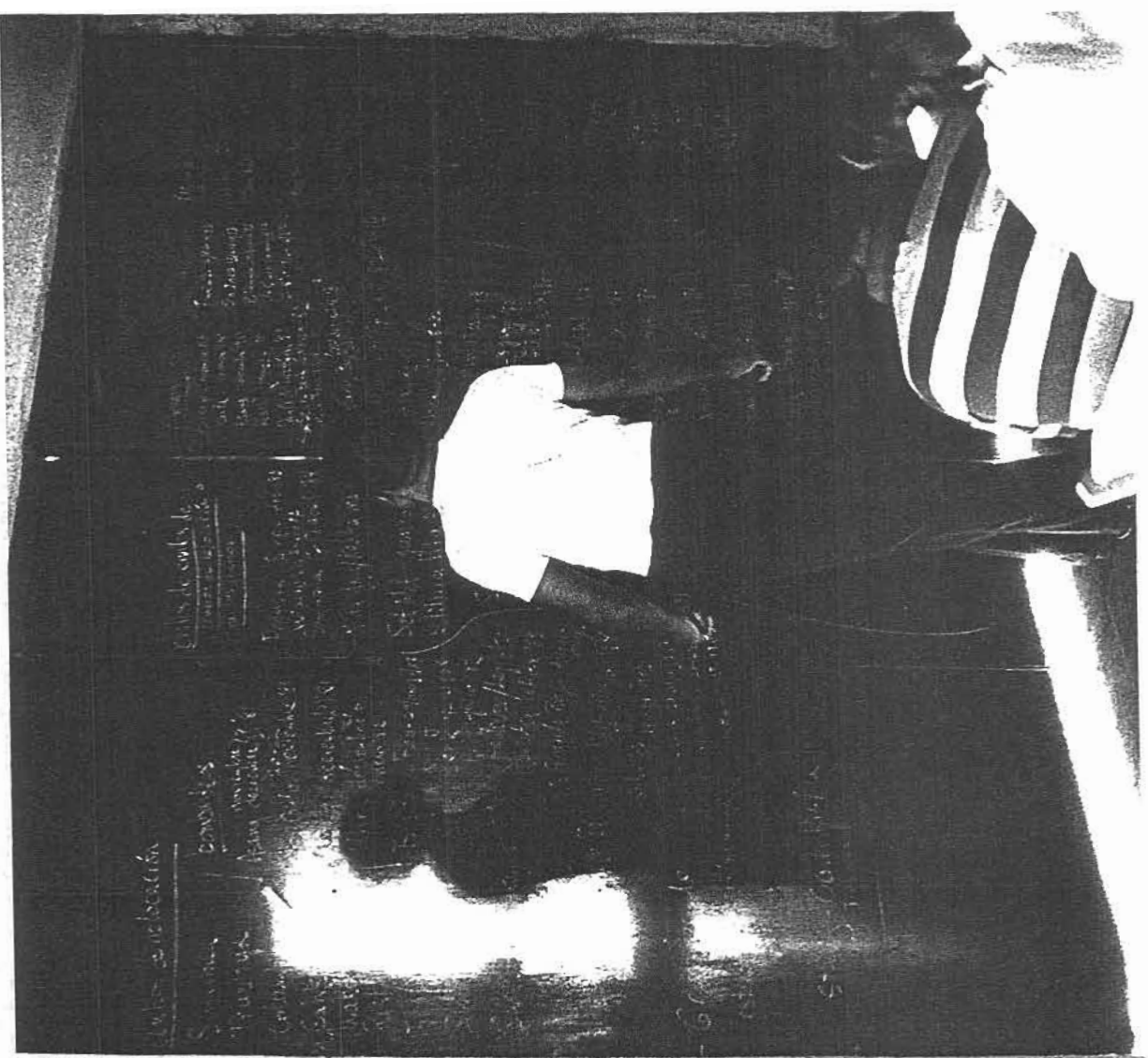

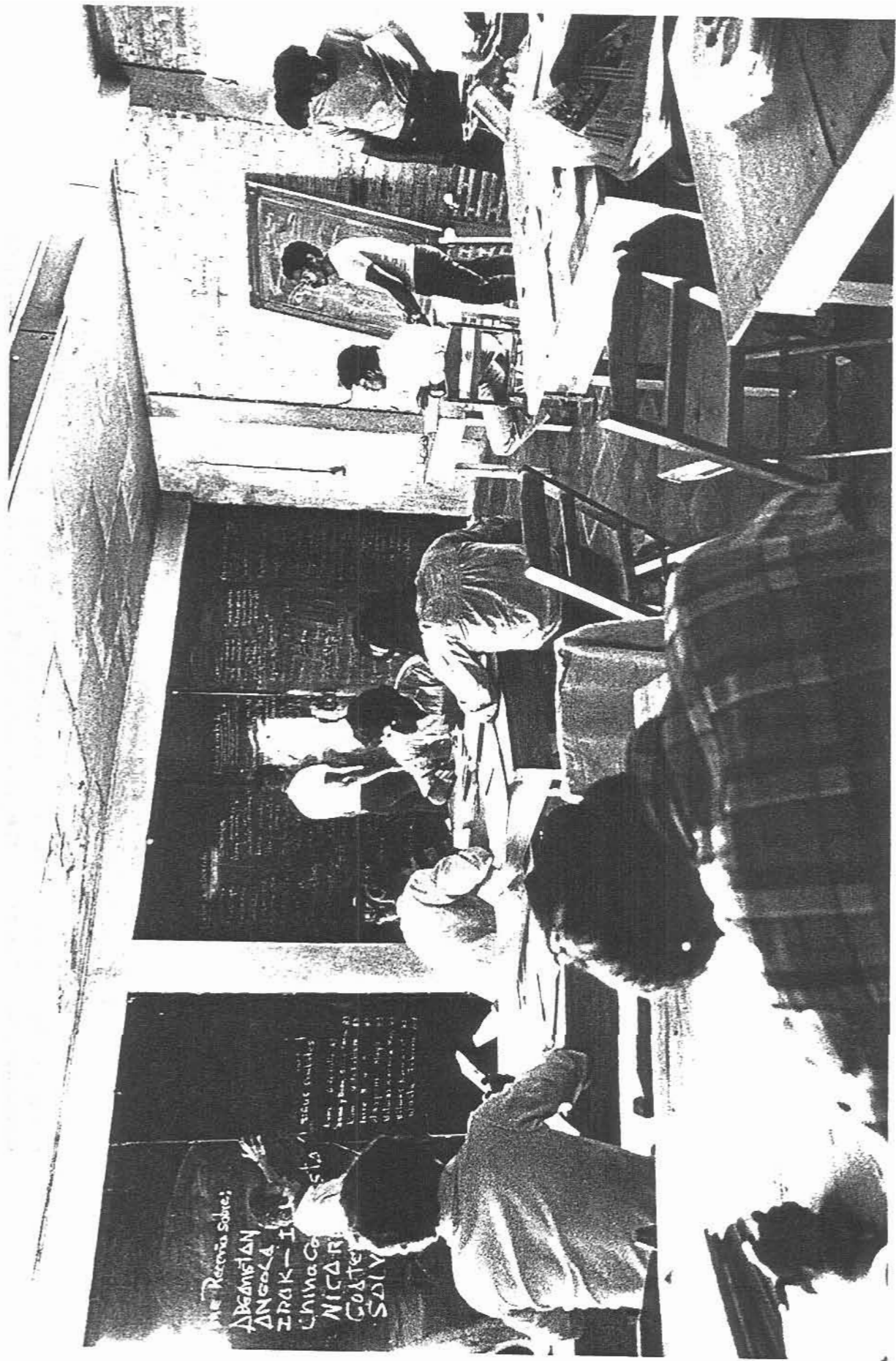

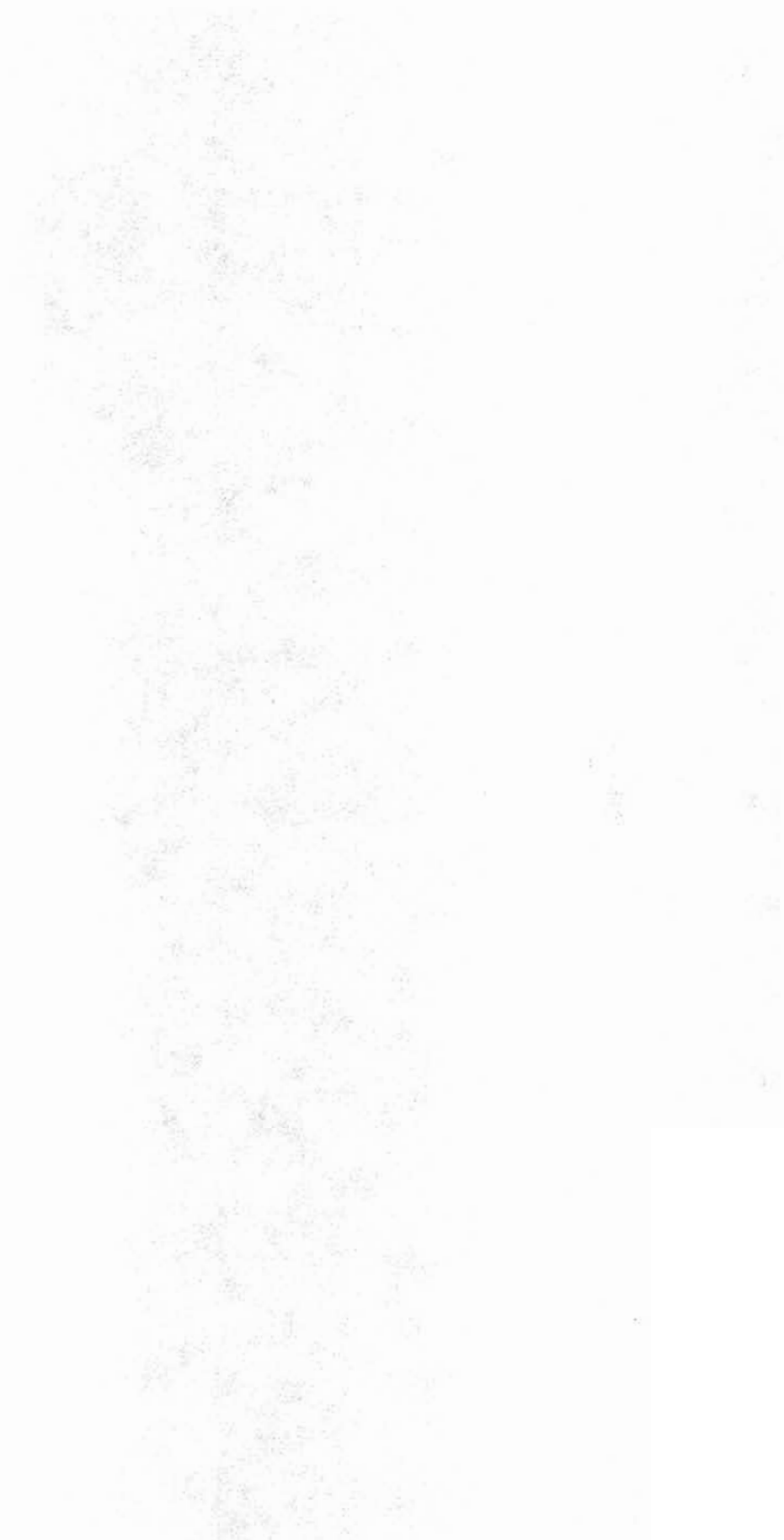

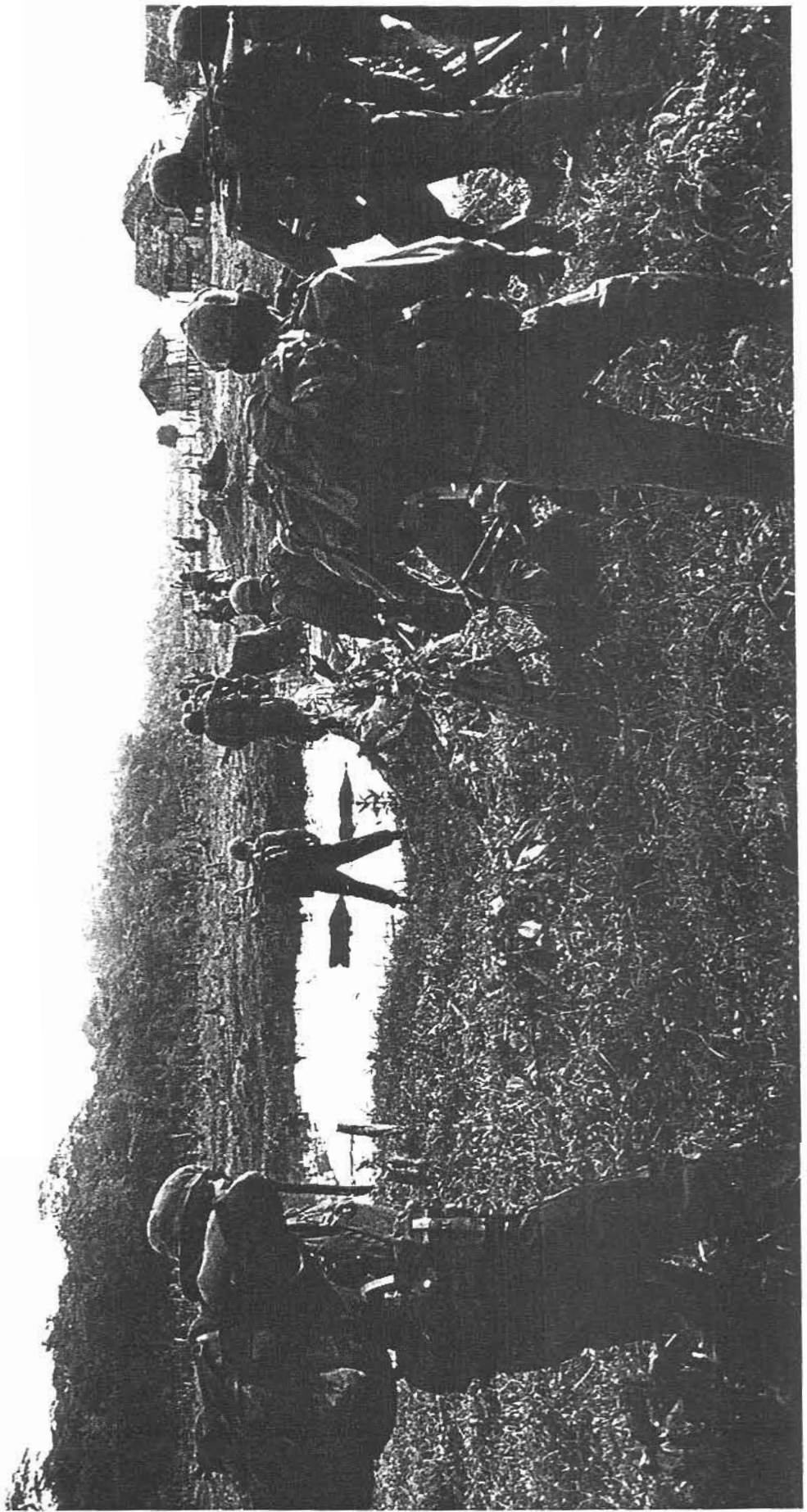

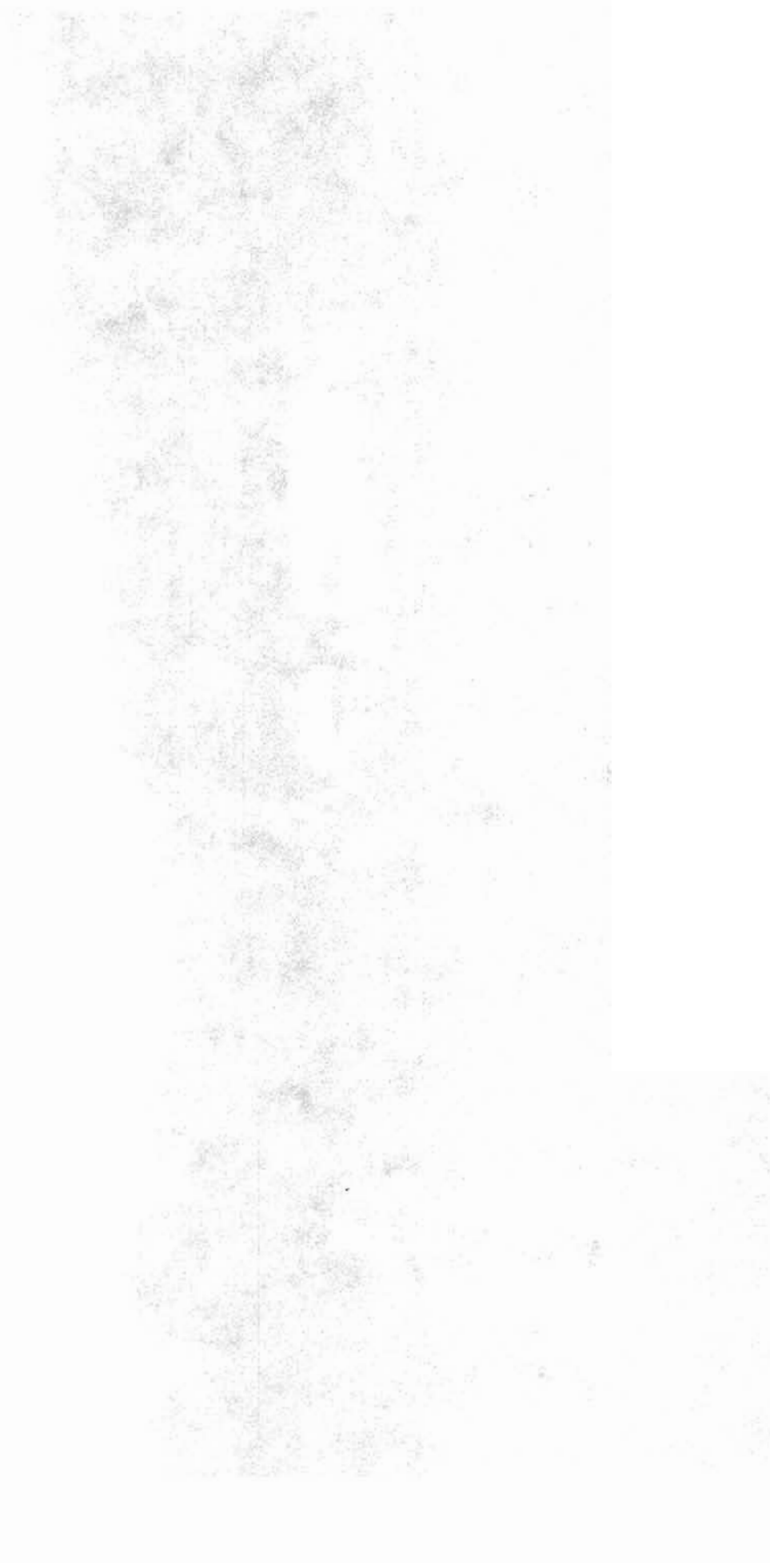


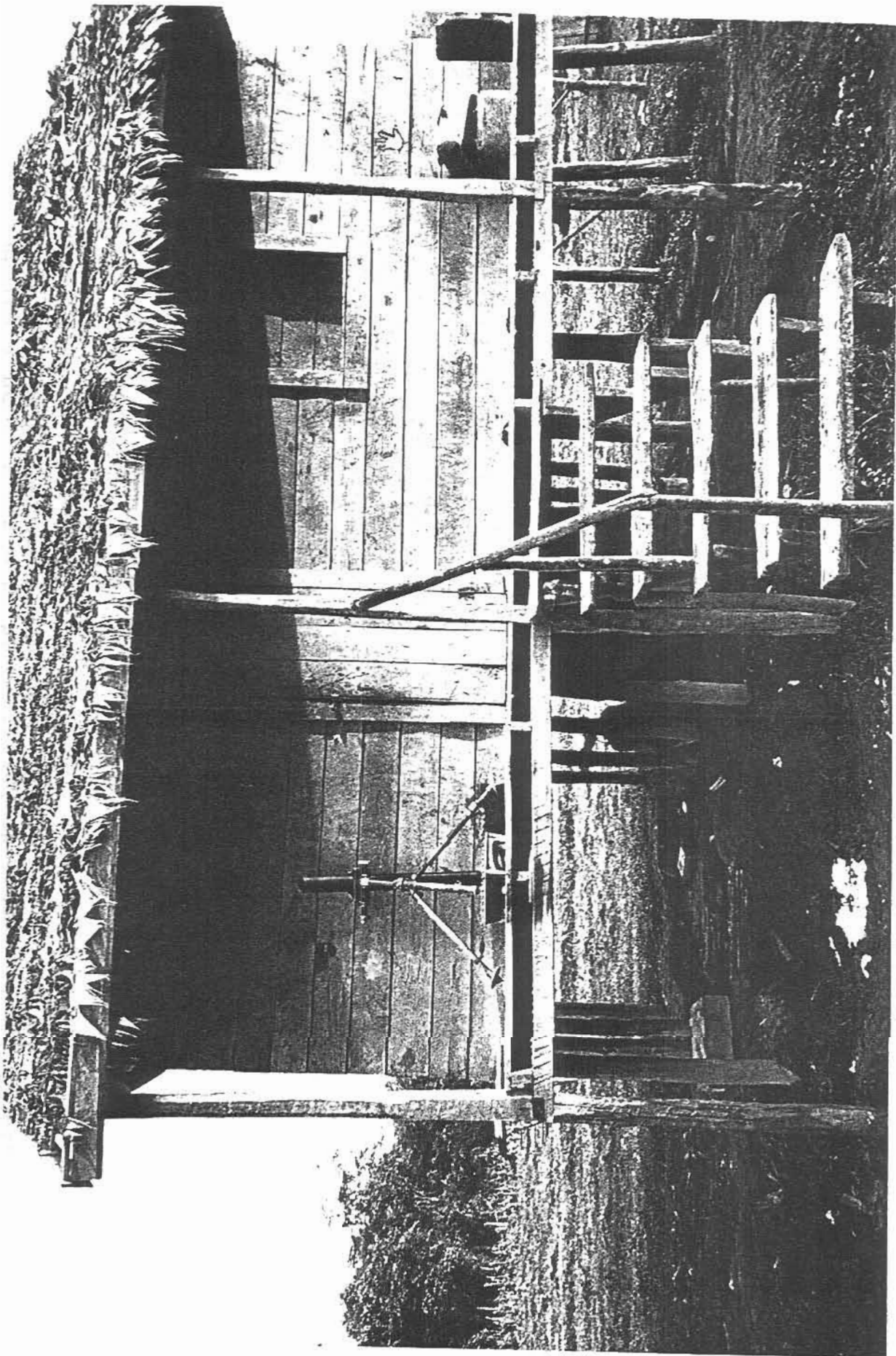

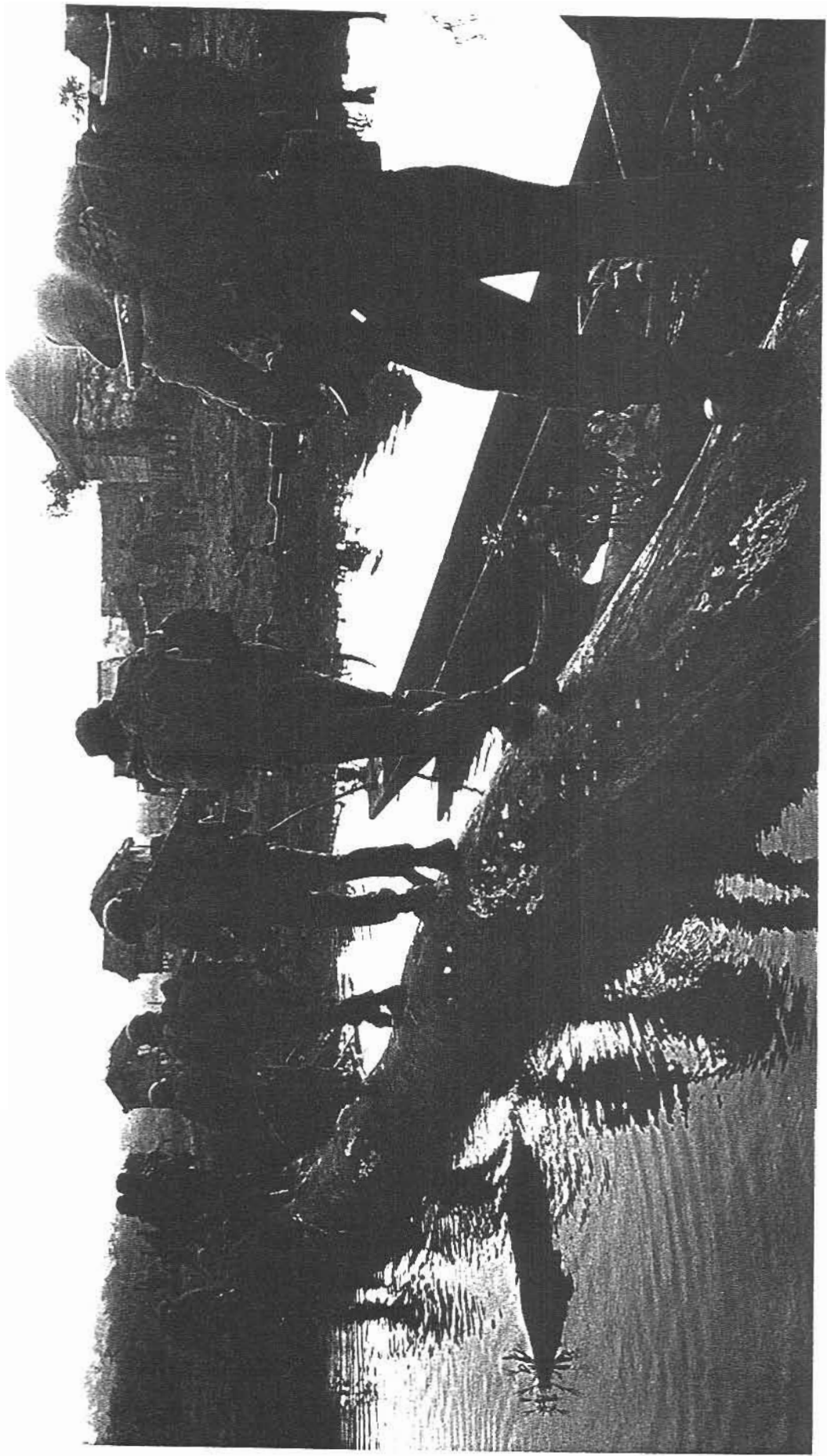

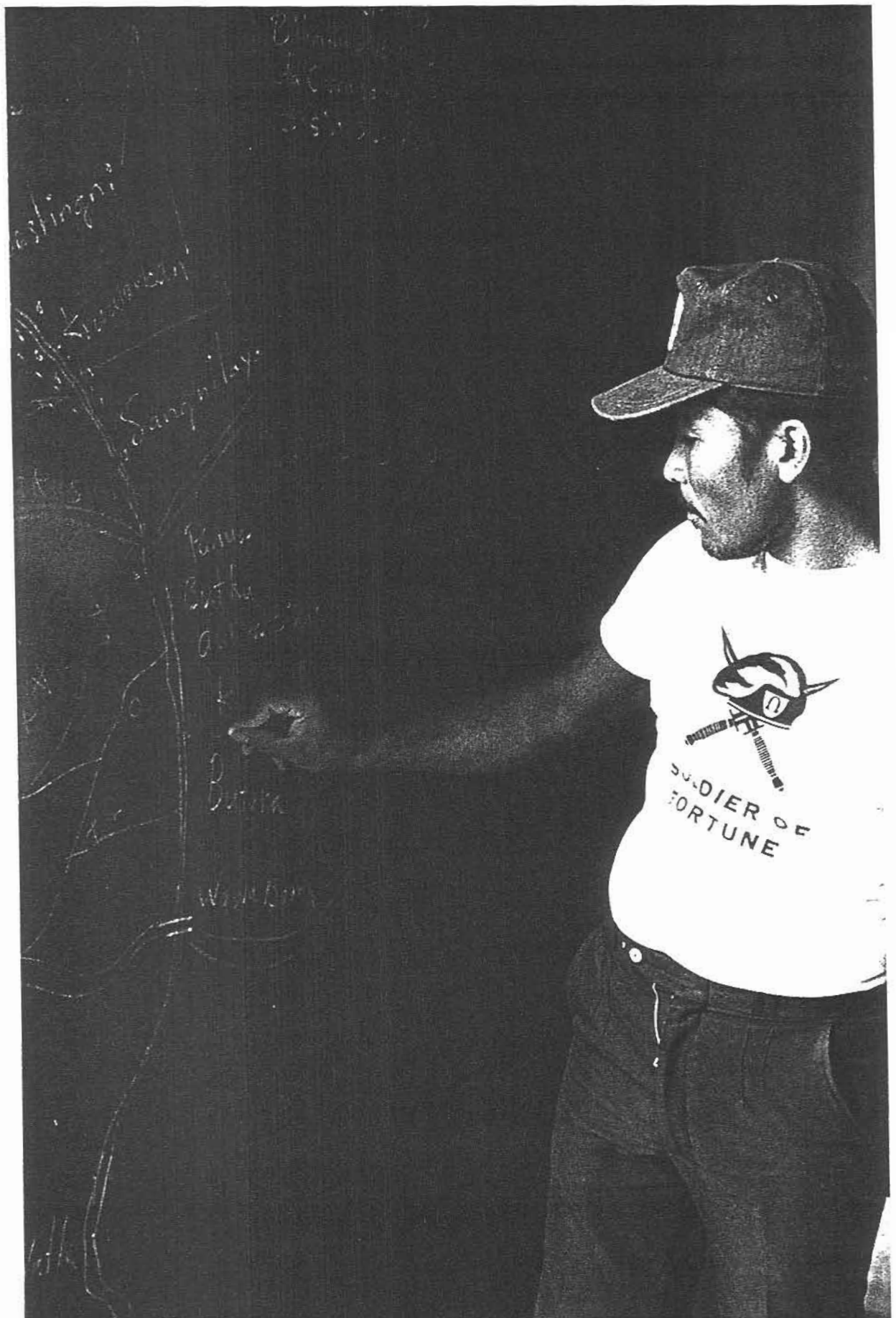

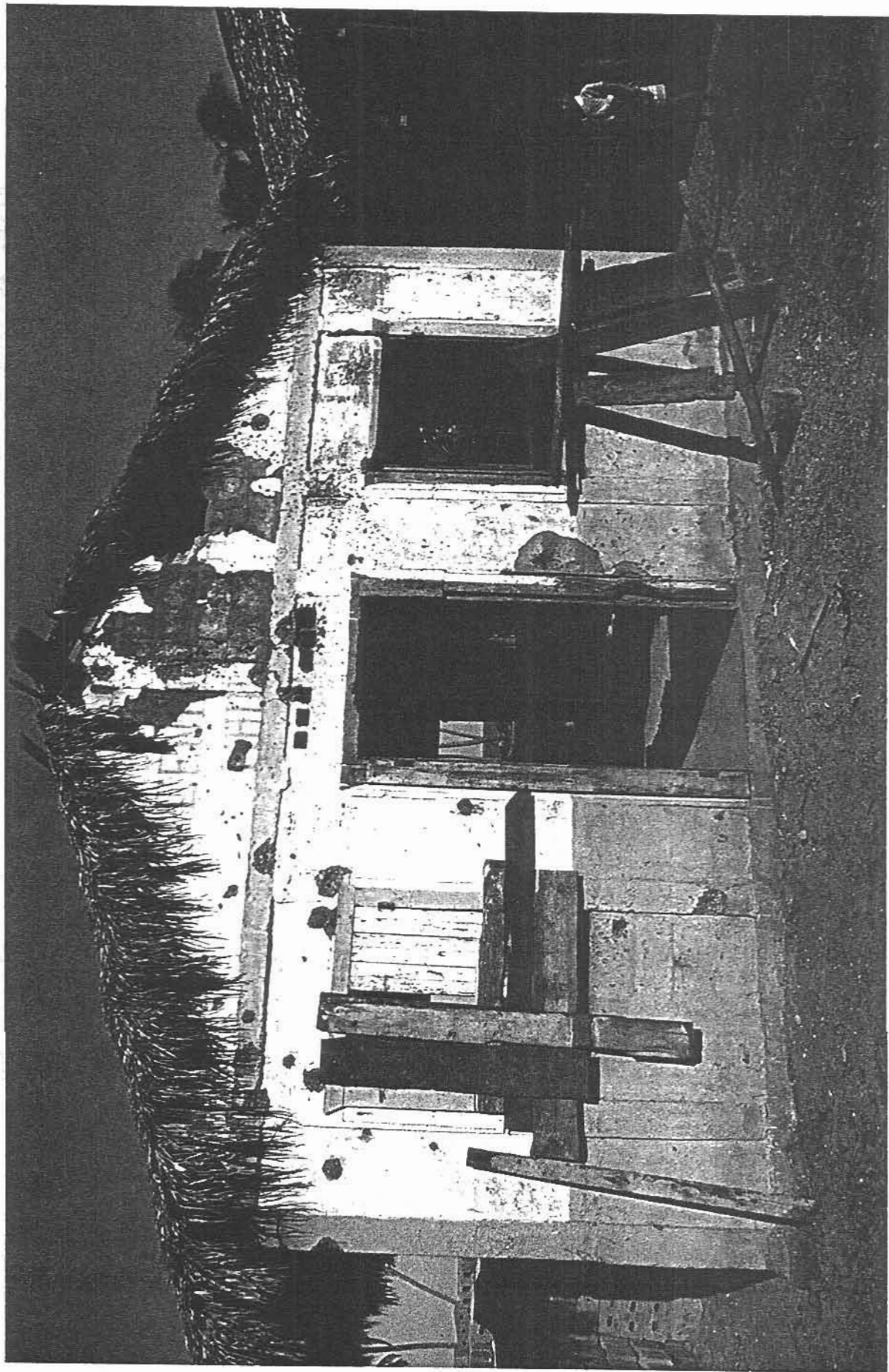

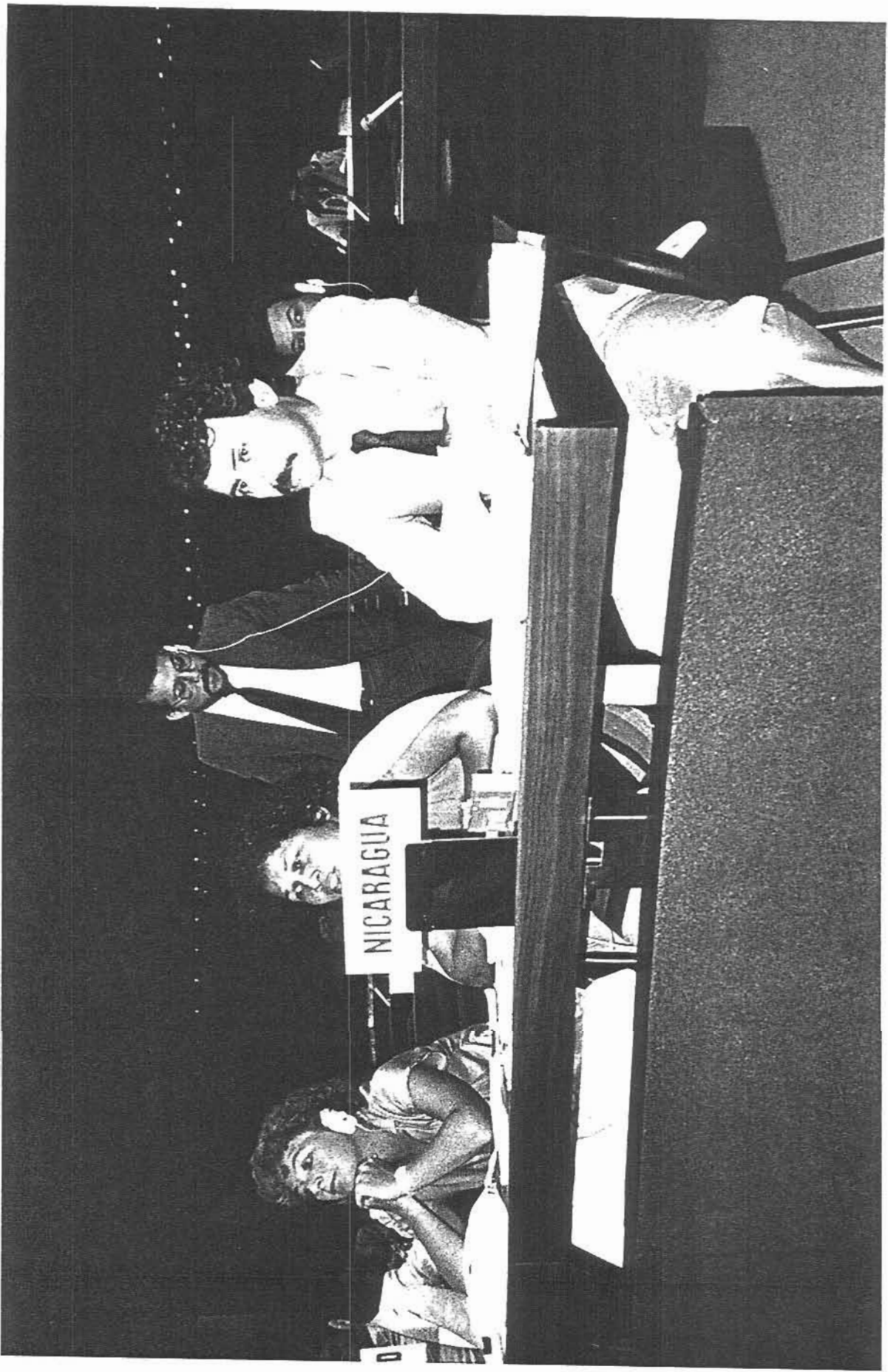
SOLDIER OF FORTUNE
