On Friday, February 23, 1996, a historic 80+ year old barn sitting on 10 acres of private property within the Capitol Forest of Washington was destroyed by arson. The barn was owned, restored and used by the Tacoma Trail Cruisers Motorcycle Club. Arson investigators believe that individual(s) entered the private property at approximately 1:30 a.m. On February 23, and set fire to the building. A concrete pump house was also spray painted with the slogans:

"Stop Destroying The Rest Of The Wildland"
"ORV = DEATH"

Between September 3 and 4, 1995, a 3 year old Brahma-cross cow belonging to Alan Flournoy was shot 15 times in the right side with a small caliber handgun. The cow was shot on late Sunday evening or early Monday morning in a remote area of Government Flats about 16 miles west of Paskenta, California. The animal died on Tuesday.

The Tehama County Secret Witness Program is offering \$1,750 reward for information leading to an arrest and conviction. Anyone with information on this senseless killing is asked to call the Tehama County Sheriffs Department at 916-529-7900.

WARNING STILL IN EFFECT FOR PIPE BOMBS IN GILA WILDERNESS

SILVER CITY, NM --- A U.S. Forest Service warning is still in effect for horsemen, hikers and backpackers recreating in wilderness of the Gila Wilderness. On July 6, 1995, a home-made pipe bomb was found in the Gila Wilderness of the Gila National Forest. The pipe bomb was found lying next to the trail in the White Creek area of the Gila Wilderness and was described as an 8 inch section of PVC pipe capped off on both ends with the joints sealed in waterproof glue and a short section of fuse sticking out of the middle of the device. The device was removed and destroyed by Forest Service Law Enforcement personnel. This was the forth explosive device found within the Gila Wilderness in a one year period. Other incidents included a small cache of plastic explosives found on May 18, 1995 along Iron Creek Mesa and two pipe devices with trip wires designed to fire a shot gun shell. The U.S. Forest Service advises the public to be observant of their surroundings while recreating on any areas of the Forest. WANTED

INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF PERSON(S) INVOLVED IN ECO-SABOTAGE

The Churchill County, Nevada Sheriff's office is seeking information leading to the arrest of individual(s) involved in the arson of a cow camp in the Stillwater Mountain Range near Fallon, Nevada. A bunkhouse and cookhouse owned by the Kent family in West Lee Canyon were burned to the ground between March 19 and 24, 1995. The arsonist(s) attempted to burn down the nearby corrals and water facilities and the ranch sustained heavy damage. BLM signs along the road to the ranch were also destroyed by apparent shotgun blasts.

HELP EXPOSE ECO-TERRORISM

"Where are the warnings about Earth Firsters who see the planet as something sacred, and those they claim violate it as infidels worthy of death?"

Former BLM Director Jim Baca (appointed by Clinton) has been touring the country for "The Wilderness Society" blaming the Wise Use movement for anti-government violence. Thomas asks, "So why isn't Bill Clinton being blamed, in part, for the bombs mailed by the Unabomber during his administration? And why hasn't Kaczynski been labeled a left-wing environmental extremist? It's because "left" is considered good and "right" is considered wrong by the political and media elites."
